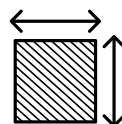




**HOUGHTON COUNTY LAND BANK PROPERTY**



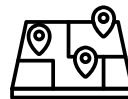
322 Seventh Street is a two-story, plus attic, wood frame house built around approx. 1912. As part of the redevelopment, the community is looking to move the building 650' south of its current location on 5th Street to the middle of the 400 block to a village owned lot. Moving would address drainage, parking, and ease of development conditions at current site. New site would allow for easier development of the attic space into an efficiency apartment, conversion of the front ground floor apartment back to a shop space, and allow for accessible parking to be easily constructed. 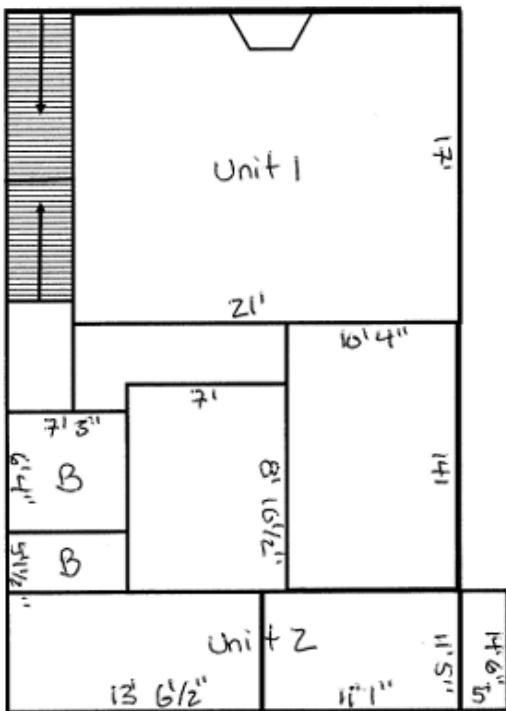

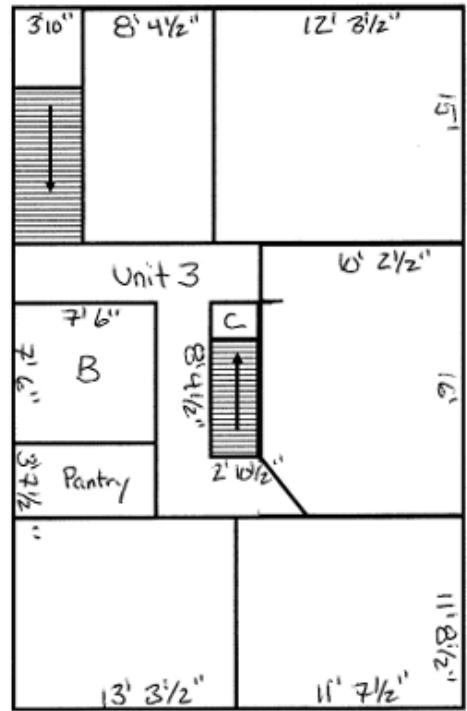

# FLOOR PLAN

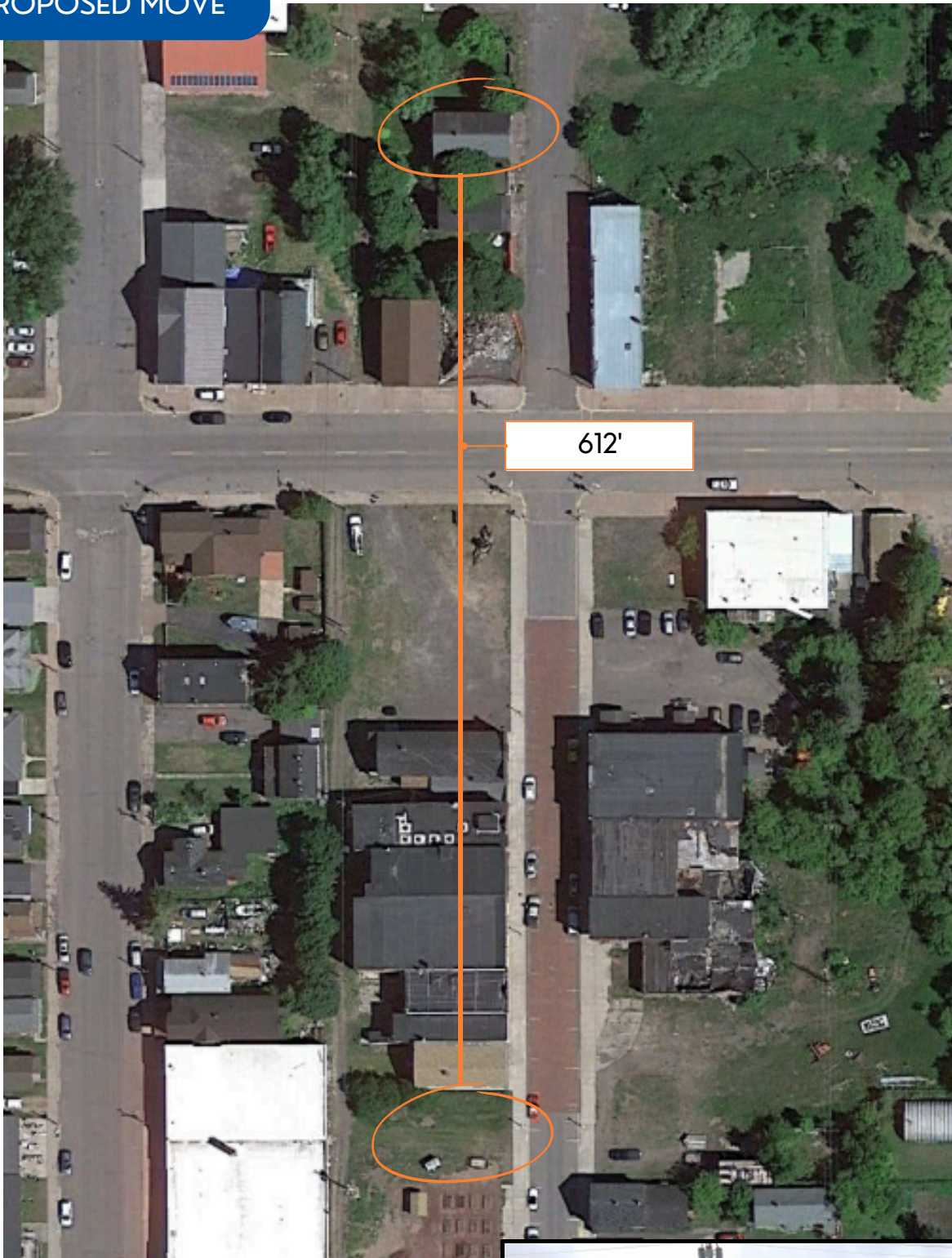


First Floor
